## Hilberry Summer Repertory

Wayne State University's Hilberry Theatre has announced plans for its first season of summer repertory.

Foyda's farce, "A Flea in Her Ear," will open the season on July 24. The farce will alternate evenings with "A Funny Thing Happened on the Way to the Forum," the musical comedy.

Another first will be the production of a children's play, "Aladdin and the Wonderful Lamp," for matinee performances.

In announcing the summer repertory, Wayne's theatre director Leonard Leone said it was designed to satisfy a two-fold need.

"We want to counteract the city's cultural slow-down in the summer, when people tend to have more leisure time and most children are out of school," he said. "We also feel a responsibility to our own students to provide a program in which they can continue to practice and perfect their craft during the summer months."

The season will continue for six weeks, closing August 30.

Eight weeks of plays and four separate activities will keep the University of Detroit Theatre bright this summer. The elements between June 23 and Aug. 30, as announced by Dr. James Rodgers, chairman of the theatre faculty:

- The Summer Musical Festival, July 11 to August 30 - Three musicals: "Carnival," "Little Mary Sunshine," and "Once Upon a Mattress."
- Stock '68 - The first U. of D. resident, paid company.
- The High School Actors' Workshop, June 23 to August 30.
- Summer Institute for High School Teachers of Drama, June 23 to August 1.
- The Outside "In" Theatre - Off beat performances in the Ford Life Sciences Bldg. courtyard.

THE SUMMER staff working with Rodgers includes costumer Nancy Duda, director Dominic Missini, designer Charles Ceroux assisted by Michael Huesman, and supervising the teachers institute, the Rev. James Calne, S.J.

The Stock '68 company includes company members from U. of D., Western Michigan University, Oakland University, Eastern University, Wayne State and Marygrove College.

The Stock '68 chorus is composed exclusively of U. of D. students.

The high school workshop students will be involved in major productions, as well as "The Outside 'In' Theatre shows.

THE FESTIVAL will open in the U. of D. Theatre 113 which was installed in the Ford Life Sciences Bldg. last summer with "Once Upon a Mattress," Thursday, July 10.

"Little Mary Sunshine" follows on July 24; "Carnival" opens Aug. 7, and all plays will alternate in repertory Aug. 19 through 30.
