A new program for pianists and a special theory class for performers have been added to the curriculum for the 1969 Scholastic College Summer Music School. The program is now accepting applications for enrollment. In the four-week session beginning July 7, according to Director Wayne Dunlap.

Now in its third year, the school will again offer daily classes in chamber music and ensemble playing for high school age and other young advanced musicians in the area.

The curriculum will include chamber music, orchestra, music theory, and special courses in style and musicianship.

"The new program for pianists has been developed in response to many inquiries and will provide, in addition to the regular curriculum, work in ensemble playing, accompanying, and sight reading," Dunlap said.

"The new theory class will concern itself with examination and study of musical works as they relate directly to their performance," Dunlap said.

An enrollment approaching 100—more than double that of the first year of the school—is expected this year. Enrollment, however, will again be selective in order to provide the instrumental balance desired to meet the musical objectives of the school.

"Each student is assigned to a faculty member who is a professional performing musician on the student's instrument," Dunlap explained. "With our ensemble approach, students work on an almost one-to-one basis with the instructor."

"We cannot accept a disproportionate number of pianists or string players, for example, because that would defeat the purpose of our ensemble approach," he explained.

"This is by way of saying that early enrollment is advisable, in fact, we are asking that students we know by June 15 of their intent to enroll."

CLASSES are scheduled for

8 a.m. to noon daily, Monday through Friday. Student orchestra rehearsals are scheduled three afternoons a week until 2:30 p.m.

Tuition for the four-week session is \$50, an increase of \$10 over past years.
