

# Mary Jewell wins mile run

## N. Farmington girls finish 5th in NSL

Placing first in eight of the 14 events—including all three relays—Westland John Glenn last week blasted past its four league rivals and totally dominated the Northwest Suburban League girls conference track meet.

The Rockets rolled up 80 1/2 points, well ahead of Livonia Franklin, which tallied 65 points. Redford Thurston placed third with

46 1/2. Garden City East earned 32 and North Farmington garnered 13.

Five league records were broken during the meet and another pair were tied.

Thurston's Chris Wandy set new conference standards in the shot put and the discus. Glenn's Karen McDougal established a new mark in the 400-yard run and the Rockets' Bob and mile relay crews set

new records in these events.

Cheryl Williams and Kathy McDougal, both from Glenn, tied the respective long jump records in the 100- and the 200-yard dashes.

Wandy and Karen McDougal were both individual double winners. About all that North Farmington had to cheer about was the first place effort of Mary Jewell in the mile run.

## NFHS netters win league meet

North Farmington had players involved in every single and double final match in winning the Northwest Suburban League Tennis meet last week at Westland John Glenn.

"It was between us and Westland John Glenn in just about every round," said North coach Norm Stankowski, who guides the Rockets to a 15-1 dual meet record and the school's first league title since 1964. "Really, by the time the final came around, I think we needed only one more match victory to wrap it up."

In the No. 1 singles final, Steve David Epstein defeated Thurston's Ron Peak in

three sets, 6-3, 4-2, 7-6. Glenn's Dave Terwilliger defeated North's Chris Wandy, 1-6, 4-1, 6-2, in the No. 2 singles final.

North also lost No. 3 singles, where Livonia Franklin's Joe Brown beat Stu Parn, 4-6, 4-3, 6-4. Glenn's Bobbie Dubois defeated North's Gordie Bessert, 6-3, 6-4, in the No. 4 singles.

Glenn's No. 2 doubles team of Pat McBride and Gary Walden won over North's Randy Arns and Jon Sams, 6-3, 6-3.

John Glenn, runner up in the league meet, was the only team to beat North Farmington in dual meets this season.
