Survey finds WSU grads serve state

The great bulk of Wayne State University graduates still remain in Michigan to live and work and most plan to continue with graduate education, a WSU Placement Services survey indicates.

The findings brought expressions of satisfaction from WSU officials, who are proud of their claim that WSU "serves Michigan first" and frequently point out that more WSU grads than those of any other state university give Michigan's economy the benefit of their education.

Two earlier surveys yielded similar results. A census of the December 1972 graduates showed 86.4 per cent took jobs in Michigan and a poll of the June 1973 grads revealed that 96 per cent stayed in the state.

THE MOST recent confidential survey covers 8,586 graduates of the December 1973 and June 1974 classes, of whom 3,554 or 54 per cent responded. Among the highlights:

- 88 per cent took jobs in Michigan after receiving their degrees.
- 53 per cent plan to continue school, with another 29 per cent undecided.
- Of those committed to continuing, 48 per cent already have been accepted or have applied for admission to a graduate school.

• 57 per cent said their college education "adequately prepared" them for their jobs, with another 20 per cent saying they were "partially" prepared.

Of the 3,554 responding to the questionnaire, 1,911 received bachelor's degrees, 1,223 earned master's degrees, 146 law degrees, 39 educational specialist degrees, 40 doctor of education (Ed. D.) degrees, 10 doctor of philosophy (Ph. D.) degrees and 52 medical (M.D.) degrees. The mean starting salary for 1,158 bachelor's degree holders who volunteered income information was \$19,280.
