Akiva Day students mark Jerusalem Day

On the 28th day of the Hebrew month of Iyar, the city of Jerusalem was unified during the war of June 1967. The year during Yom Yerushalayim - Jerusalem Day - festivities, students of Akiva Hebrew Day School in Southfield re-enacted the events leading to the recapture of the "Kotel," the western wall.

The western wall is the most sacred site for Jews throughout the world. The students designed a model of the western wall and several of them dressed as Israeli soldiers. They ran towards the wall as did soldiers during the Six Day War and re-enacted the dramatic act of Rabbi Shimon Goren, the chief rabbi of Israel, who blew a Shofar (ram's horn) at the wall in the midst of the turmoil and thereby liberated the wall. The western wall has become a site of prayer and deep human emotion.

On Jerusalem Day, the students dressed in blue and white, decorated the halls of the school with pictures and sayings, and chanted the prayers according to the special rate developed by the Chief Rabbinate of Israel.

Selected students participated in a quiz on Jerusalem which included knowledge about the history and geography of Jerusalem, its sacred sites, its place in the Bible, its people and its songs.

The PTFO of the school ordered a luncheon for the students and many award-winning visitors participated in the school's celebration.

Author calls Agnew a plus for Zionism

Journalist Robert St. John said recently he believes Spiro Agnew's recent public statements concerning Jewish control of the U.S. media is a "plus factor for Zionism."

The author spoke at an Israel Bond Reception in the Southfield home of Mr. and Mrs. Irving Nussbaum. He lauded Agnew's exposure on TV and in the press as one of five positive factors aiding Zionism.

"Agnew is making the position of the anti-Semite look ridiculous to all Americans," he said. "As a matter of record, only three per cent of all U.S. newspapers are owned by people of the Jewish faith."

According to St. John, other positives are: "The terrible situation in Lebanon, which proves to the world how impossible is PLO leader Arafat's demand for an Israeli-Palestinian state."

"The occupied West Bank is quieting down."

"The Israeli Parliament has outlawed the creation of more settlements in the West Bank."

"Politically, Egypt is in one camp, Syria in another."

"On the minus side, St. John listed No Arab leader has come forward with an offer to negotiate for peace, there is a lack of unity among Israeli leaders as to how to best seek peace, and Israel is still in trouble, financially."
