The hand in the diagram was dealt at a local duplicate game. North-South reached a substandard game, but the real flaw in the bidding is North's rebid. Two notrump would have been a better choice. South would pass and depend on the play, would take at least eight tricks.

West dutifully led a heart; declarer played the jack from dummy and East won the queen. He returned a spade to West's ace. Declarer played low from dummy and East cashed two hearts and the ace of clubs to defeat the contract. Declarer mis-guessed the diamond and lost another trick for a two trick set.
