EMU sets nuclear medicine program

The Eastern Michigan University Board of Regents has aproved a proposal to grant a bachelor's degree in nuclear medicine technology. The program, unique independent of the 1977 fall semester. The new curriculum at Eastern, a cooperative effort with the nuclear medicine section of University Hospital in Ann Arbor, will include three years of course work at EMU followed by a 13-month integraphy at University Hospital to study the specialized aspects of nuclear medicine technology.

nologists work under the direction of a physician and utilize radioisotope materials to aid in the di-agnosis and treatment of diseases.

Students entering the program at Eastern will be required to take anatomy, radiation biology, general and organic chemistry, pathology, radiosotope technology, physics and other courses Students will be a 2.5 grade point average in these courses and no grade below a "C" in any science course.
