**CITY OF FARMINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS (Summary)**

A Regular Meeting of the Farmington City Council was held on Monday, May 2, 1977, in the Council Chambers, 23600 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan. Councilmen Bennett, Hartsock, Tupper and Yoder were present; Mayor Richardson, absent. City Manager Deadman, Directors Byrnes and Jones, Attorney Kelly and Acting Clerk Busby were present.

The students and their principal from Farmington Senior High School, who are to participate in Student Government Day activities on May 3, were introduced. Minutes of previous meetings were approved as corrected. Minutes of other boards were received.

Sign variance was granted as requested for Frank's Nursery, 21500 Grand River. Permission granted to Farmington Raquet Club to display temporary sign. Council accepted proposed amendments to the City Code.

Low bid of Case Power & Equipment Company, Southfield, Michigan, was accepted for a Tractor Backhoe-Front End Loader with optional equipment, \$17,891.24. City Attorney was instructed to intercede on Farmington's behalf in the lawsuit Ronald and Cynthia Hubert vs. City of Farmington.

City Manager reported on proposed emergency sewer rate increase from the City of Detroit.

Council received Progress Report on Area-wide Fire Services Study. Council agreed to review the possible vacation of the alley between Adams Street and Shawwassee on June 8, 1977; also to review discontinuing the rubbish pickup along the alleyway running east and west between Wilmuth and Cass Streets.

Mr. Ralph Held, Mr. Eugene Donnelly and other residents of Alta Loma Street requested the relocation of the proposed exit and entrance ramps to 186 Expressway.

Public Safety Department Quarterly Report was received. Quarterly Financial Report, Water & Sewer Funds, received.

Council agreed to advise the SEMTA Board of Directors of their opposition to the subway and heavy rail transit proposal and their support of the bus and light rail concept; also to request that consideration be given to the transportation needs of southern Oakland County.

Monthly bills were approved.

Meeting adjourned at 9:55 p.m.
