

# H.P. no match for S' field trackmen

Southfield High track coach Chuck Balog had been worried about Hazel Park spoiling his team's unbeaten record and its chances for its first Southeastern Michigan Association title ever.

No worry. Southfield defeated Hazel Park, 90-68, in an SMA meet last Thursday at Southfield. The Blue Jays are 8-0 overall and 4-0 in the league.

"It was easier than I thought because our kids really came through," Balog said. "A kid who'd been vaulting 10 feet and shouldn't have gotten a place, vaulted 11 feet and got second place. A 16.4 high hurdler runs 15.9 and takes second. Those kinds of things made it easier."

Southfield, which won 11 of the 16 events and showed plenty of depth, had a double winner in junior Dave Walmsworth, who took the discus at 132-3 and the shot put in a personal best 51-6. Teammate Scott Kurylo also turned in a personal best in the pole vault with a 12-6 effort.

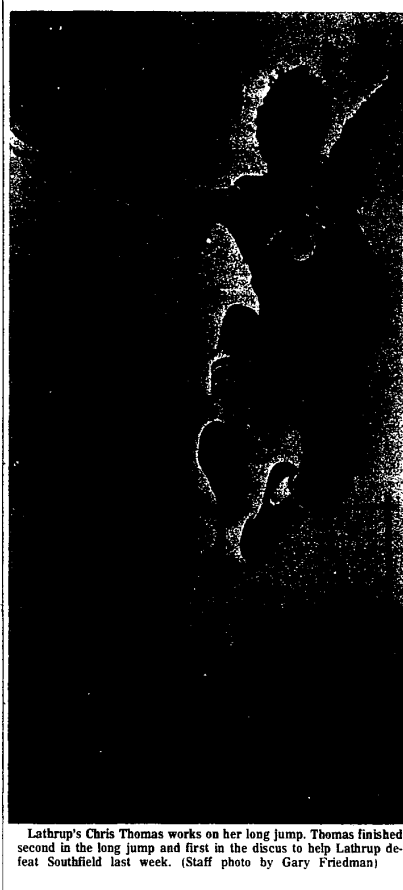
Southfield took first in all three relays. The 880 crew (Mitch Moses, Stu Brozgold, Shawn Rowley and Marvin Miles) finished in 1:33.8. The 440 team (Joe Perry, Ken Raby, John Binner and Tom Hamway) logged a 1:45.8, and the mile relay (Brian Raby, Dennis Sleep, Moses and Miles) went 3:33.3.

## Softballers triumph

Lisa Dehoyas pitched a four-hitter to lead Southfield-Lathrup past Farmington Harrison, 8-6, in a non-league softball game last Thursday at Lathrup. The win lifted coach Jim Owens' Lathrup club to 8-5 overall.

Dehoyas went all the way, giving up four singles, striking out four and walking two. Lathrup, which had six hits, got an RBI-double from Jodi Rose. Teammate Pat Cornfield had one hit and knocked in two runs.

In another recent softball game, Southfield High upped its overall record to 6-2 with a 1-6 victory over Birmingham Seaholm in the Southeastern Michigan Association last Thursday. Southfield, coached by Jill Eulitz, has a 5-2 SMA record.

# Lathrup outruns Southfield High

Karen Winston won two individual events and ran on a winning relay to help Southfield-Lathrup defeat Southfield High, 113-23, last week in a non-league girls' track meet.

The victory left coach Ruth Hehrington's Lathrup team with a 6-1 overall record.

Winston won the 100-yard dash with a 12.0 clocking, and then finished first in the 110-yard hurdles in 1:57. She also ran a leg of Lathrup's 400-yard relay (with Bridget McNally, Jana Bentley and Joanna Jacobs on the anchor), which won in 5:31.

Lathrup, which won 12 of the 14 events, got a first in the 440-yard dash when Rhonda Finkelstein logged a 1:00.4. Teammate Linda Kunkle won the mile in 6:10.3, and Gina Kunkle took the half mile in 2:34.5. Bridget Mullane won the long jump at 15-2, and Marilyn Howe finished first in the shot put at 27-3.

Southfield, which didn't have its full team, got a first from sophomore Theresa Kopach in the 220-yard dash (1:27.9). She also finished second in the 440 at 1:00.5, just one-tenth of a second behind Finkelstein.

In another recent girls' track meet, Hazel Park defeated Southfield, 80-56, in the Southeastern Michigan Association. The loss dropped Southfield to 1-5 overall and 1-3 in the SMA.

Kopach won the 440 (1:01.5) and the

220 (1:27.4), and finished fourth in the high jump. Southfield's Adrienne Harrell won the long jump (14-9.4), and teammate Diane Klemperer took the two mile run (13:48.3). Southfield's 440 relay Carol Parvon, Theresa Robinson, Kim Thomas and Harrell won in 5:50.

Both Lathrup and Southfield have dual meets on Tuesday. Southfield travels to Farmdale for an SMA meet at 4:15 p.m., while Lathrup moves to Birmingham Groves for a 7 p.m. Metro Suburban Association contest.
