

Registration set for art classes

Farmington area residents who are wrestling with that urge to paint something besides the garage can sign up for art instruction at the Farmington Community Center.

Registration for the classes begins at 9:30 a.m. June 8 and will continue until the class is filled. Persons who enroll on June 8 should be present at the center. Enrollment by mail and phone will be handled on June 9. Mail enrollments which include a check will be given preference.

ART FOR YOUNGSTERS gives children in grades one to sixth a look at different types of art. Class will focus in heightening awareness, building self confidence and developing the individual creative imagination of the youngsters. Sand casting, batik and drawing will be included in the projects. The class is offered on Tuesday and Thursday. The first class begins June 28. The second session begins July 18. Six class sessions will cost \$20, including materials.

Children who are in first to third grade will meet between 9:30 a.m.-10:45 a.m. Youngsters who are in the fourth through the sixth grade meet at 11 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. Jackie Melissus will instruct the classes.

CALLIGRAPHY FOR CHILDREN will be open to youngsters who are in the fourth grade or older. Beginning June 28, the classes will meet from 1-2 p.m. Six session will cost \$14. There is an additional \$2 fee for materials. Sue Ebel will teach the children the basic strokes and exercises of calligraphy. The Italic hand or cursive curve will be mastered in class. Mrs. Ebel has a fine arts degree from Madonna College and teaches painting at the school.

DRAWING AND PAINTING workshop for young adults is open to stu-

dents who are in the ninth to 12th grades. There are two sessions for the class which meets on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The first session begins June 28. Classes will be from 1-3 p.m. The second class begins July 19 from 1-3 p.m. The six sessions will cost \$18, excluding materials. Workshop will focus on drawing, design and the basic elements of oil or acrylic painting. The class will learn how to stretch and prepare canvas as well as concentrating on the development of a personal style and discipline. If there is interest, printmaking will be added.

DRAWING AND PAINTING for junior high will be on Mondays and Wednesdays beginning June 27. Classes will be from 10 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Eight sessions will cost \$24 plus materials.

Joyce King will instruct the class. She teaches art in Belleville and is a member of the Farmington Artists Club. Color, perspective and composition will be stressed along with special skills and methods used in painting on canvas. Students will study drawing and painting of a still life collage in oil and a subject of their own choice. Advanced students will be able to pursue their own projects.

LANDSCAPE PAINTING will be in two sessions, on Tuesday and Thursday beginning July 12. The six session, which cost \$35 plus materials will meet from 9:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m. Majorie Chellstorp will teach the class which will paint on the grounds of the community center. Oils, acrylics or water color can be used by the artist. Participants are welcome to bring a lunch.

PEN AND INK SKETCHING on wood, trees and birds will begin June 28. Class will deal with still life and landscape features.
