# Farmington jogger aids Schoolcraft

Schoolcraft College means a lot to people like Maud Piggot and Joe Squires. Also to Nelson Grote and Ron Griffith, and Ken Kianfor. So the former, who help at the college and enjoy its facilities, will join with Schoolcraft's president and dean and faculty members in a special fund-raiser Triathlon from 6:30 p.m. tonight to boost Schoolcraft's coming millage election June 13. All of them, along with other deans, faculty members, administrators, students and interested citizens will run a few miles, swim a few dozen lengths or wheel along the campus bike trails to collect on pledges that have been made on their prowess. Funds thus raised will go to Citizens for Schoolcraft College, a volunteer group that is sending out mailers and making calls to support the college's request for a millage boost of eight-tenths of a cent per \$1,000 state equalized valuation to continue and upgrade its programs. Participants and pledgers will be welcome to get into the sets right up to the time Mrs. Piggot, 68-year-old Canton resident, starts swimming laps. Joe Squires gets of Farmington Hills gets into his biking and jogging and Griffith, Schoolcraft dean of student activities, sets out on a run he says will take him two to five miles. OR FOLKS may want to put their money on Dr. Grote, Schoolcraft president, or Dr. Eric J. Bradner, president emeritus, who will race on adult tricycles in the feature event that begins at 8 p.m. The runners and joggers will go at 6 p.m. and the swimmers at 7 p.m., with bikers taking over at 8 p.m. All events will be held in the area of the physical education on campus, and forms for participation or pledging are available in that building, in the office of Marvin Gans, athletic director. Plans for the fitness Triathlon developed out of conversations among members of the Citizens for Schoolcraft College on how to raise money to back the mail and telephone campaign to support the millage. "We can't use public funds for sending out communications on this," explained a member of the committee, "but the people doing the work are donating a great deal of time, and we need some financial backing." Mrs. Piggot's enthusiasm for swimming got the idea going, and then Griffith volunteered to go into his running act, wearing a T-shirt bearing the name of the Women's Resource Center and carrying a WRC tote bag as a handicap. At that point Dr. Grote remarked he'd be willing to ride one of those big bicycles on a bike trail if he could find the vehicle. Dr. Gans said he had one, and he was sure he could get another should Dr. Grote wish to challenge Dr. Bradner. MAUD PIGGOT hopes to do lots of dollars worth of good for Schoolcraft as she heads into her swimming act. A retired nurse, she became interested in both swimming and the college in recent years. "I moved to an apartment in Canton where there was a pool," she explained, "so I taught myself to swim. I don't swim like everybody else, but I enjoy it and swim at the school or at the apartment just about every day." Her involvement with Schoolcraft came after she enrolled in a "Fitness-After-50" class in 1973 and then became involved in the federally-sponsored Retired Senior Volunteers Program (RSVP). That led to work with Betty Andrews, SC administrator in gerontology, on a federal program to involve more older persons in continuing education. And when the grant for that program ran out, Mrs. Piggot continued to assist in the department on a volunteer basis.
