Prizes await young anglers

Hundreds of prizes are ready for fishermen aged 5-16 in this Saturday's annual Tom Sawyer-Becky Thatcher fishing derby on the shores of Newburgh Lake.

Grand prize for the largest fish will be a two-man raft, donated by J.C. Penney Co.

The most common prize will be something for every angler who catches his or her limit of 25 panfish. These will range from kites to model planes and cars to Eppinger fishing lures, according to contest Chairman Hank Chrusciel.

FISHING BEGINS at 7 a.m. and will run until noon, and only natural bait may be used.

Sponsors are the Western Wayne County Conservation Association and the parks and recreation departments of Livonia, Dearborn Heights, Farmington, Farmington Hills, Garden City, Northville and Plymouth.

Here are the other prizes and donors for the largest fish in each species:

- Largest sunfish—sleeping bag from L. & L. Hardware, Garden City.
- Largest bluegill—back pack from Gell Sporting Goods, Livonia.
- Largest rock bass—rod and reel and set of DareDevil lures from Northwest Gun Shop, Redford Township.
- Largest bullhead—aluminum cook set for four from the conservation club.
- Largest channel catfish—hibachi from the conservation club.
- Largest calico bass (crappie)—skateboard from Donna's R & S Cap Town.
- Largest carp—aluminum cook set for two from the club.
- Largest goldfish—set of Eppinger lures.

THE NAMES of all who catch their limits of 25 panfish will be dropped into a barrel, and the winner of a drawing (no fee or tickets) will receive a 24-inch unicycle from Reliable Bicycle Shop of Livonia.

Winner of the Tom Sawyer and Becky Thatcher look-alike contests will receive bread boards, hibachi.

rods and reels, sets of Eppinger lures, a chess or checker set and yo-yos.

Youngsters who have pre-registered by mail need only pick up a number the morning of the contest at a special desk.

All others must register at the registration desk. Headquarters are near Newburgh Point along Hines Drive west of Newburgh Road in Livonia.

A special feature new be demonstrations of spin-casting, bait-casting and fly-casting techniques by the Four Seasons Club, a newly organized family fishing club that meets in Livonia. Like the Western Wayne Conservation Club, Four Seasons is affiliated with Michigan United Conservation Clubs.

Among the dignitaries present will be U.S. Rep. Carl Purgell of Plymouth, State Rep. Robert Law of Livonia and Mayor Edward H. McNamara of Livonia.

GOOD FISHING has been the rule rather than the exception at these derbies.

More than 2,500 fish have been caught in each of the past five years, and a total of 2,000 prizes will be won by lucky fishermen and those who register early, Chrusciel said.

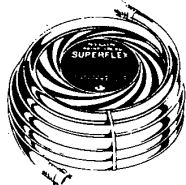

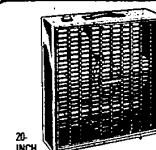

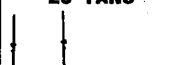
