SC summer term begins next week

Summer registration at Schoolcraft College will be held from noon to 7 p.m. next Monday, June 27. Classes begin Tuesday.
Registration is conducted in the auxiliary gym. The first hour is reserved for summer graduates—those who will complete their programs of studying during this session.

The balance of the registration period is assigned as follows: 1-3, student numbers 20,000 to 59,999; from 3-5, student numbers 60,000 to 63,999; and 5-7, student numbers 64,000 to 99,999.

Students planning to attend Schoolcraft for the first time are reminded they must be admitted to the college before registration can be completed.

The summer schedule offers nearly 100 day and evening sections in 18 different subjects. Both transfer and career studies are included among the classes being taught on campus at 18600 Haggerty, Livonia.

Tuition is \$13 a credit hour for residents of the Clarenceville, Garden City, Livonia, Northville and

Plymouth-Canton school districts. Non-resident tuition is \$26 a credit hour.
