An August wedding is planned.

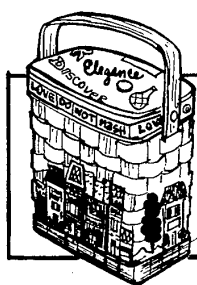
