

Road commission moves on high complaint areas

Oakland County Road commissioners today adopted an accelerated maintenance program aimed at correcting a number of high complaint areas, allotting \$230,000 of funds that accrued from maintenance operations in 1976.

Under the program, high complaint areas of 12 primary roads and in 13 subdivisions will get particular attention. Work to be done includes repairs to the road base, shoulders and surface where appropriate, said John R. Gnu, road commission chairman.

Road commission highway engineer Paul Van Roekel said, "The program will provide a higher degree of maintenance than could be done under our regular budget, such as providing asphalt overlays in some pothole areas where spot patching is no longer feasible. The program can't correct all deficiencies to specified roads, however."

Identified as having high complaint areas were the following primary roads: Lahser, Maple, Farmington, Middle Belt, Pontiac Trail, Greenfield, Twelve Mile, Fourteen Mile, Dequindre, South Boulevard, Long Lake, and Rochester Road.

Subdivisions identified as having high complaint areas were: Lotus Lake, Watkins Hills, Highland Estates, Coleman Friedman, Lorraine Manor, Lauren Hills, West Acres, Sylvan Manor, Bloomfield on the Lake, Woodcrest, Franklin Valley, Rue Versailles, and Hi Hills.

The list was compiled from records of the road commission's office of public assistance. That office routinely processes citizen complaints for appropriate action. The office may be contacted by calling 858-4804 during business hours or 858-4751 nights and weekends.

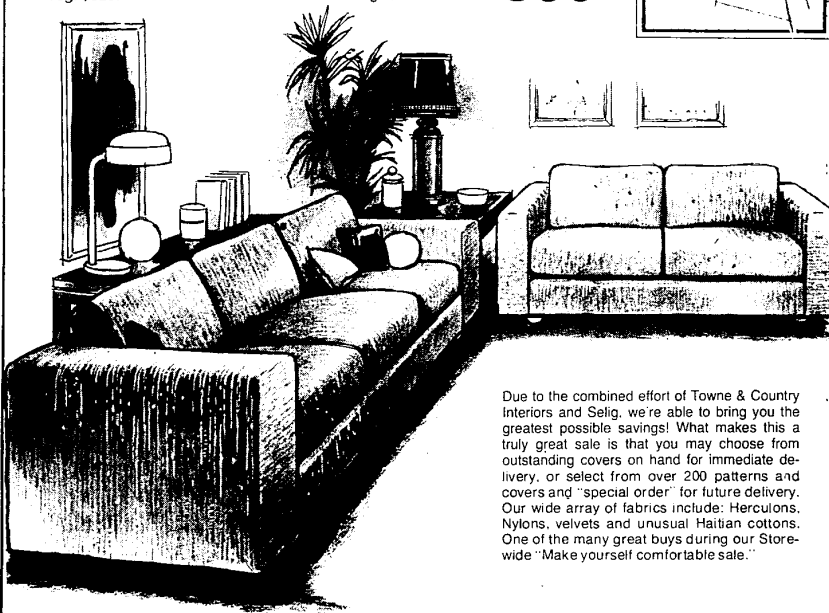

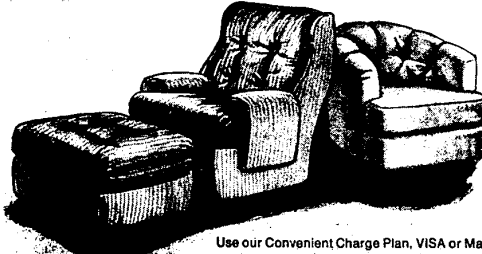

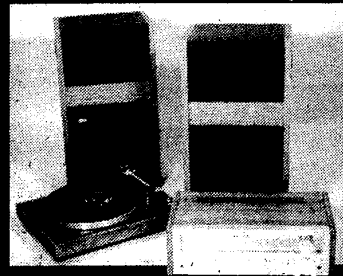
