Reducing the amount of water you use can reduce the bill in the short run, but may not affect the cost of services, since operations and mainte-

services, since operations and mainte-nance, billing costs, and pumping sta-tions are fixed costs, he adds. "It's still one of the cheapest water and sewer rates for a major metropol-itan city, even with the proposed rate increase." he said.

THE AVERAGE bill for Farmington Hills residents with both water and sewer services is about \$28, also, according to James Porter, Oakland

County engineer in the sewer, water and solid waste disposal department.


