# Spills can make a jockey's trade dangerous

> Jockey Grady Overton rode Win Bill, winner of last Saturday's \$61,700 Dowling Memorial Handicap at Detroit Race Course, with a broken hand. Still recuperating from broken bones in his foot, jockey R.O. Strausch and a third on Monday at DRC. Frequently, there isn't time or room for bailing out of the saddle, and that was the case with young apprentice jockey Tommy Knapp one recent afternoon at DRC. When his horse, Occo Tower, was jammed against the rail by another swerving thoroughbred.

Knapp, the 19-year-old son of the late Earl Knapp, one of the best riders in Detroit-history, lay motion-less on the track for several seconds. His helmet was still on. That was good. But the fall had been a violent one and the crowd was hushed.

Fortunately, almost miraculously, Knapp was only stunned. His back hurt and his face was scratched, but hospital X-rays and observation showed no serious injuries.
