

Parks offering outdoor classes

Kayaking, rock climbing, wilderness survival and duck identification are all classes being offered by the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation Division next month for those of you interested in the great outdoors.

The kayaking class will be on Sept. 6, 13, 20 and 26 at Farmington High School, with a field trip being offered on Oct. 1. Fee for the class is \$39. The course will teach the basic techniques

of handling these responsive river crafts. It consists of 12 hours of pool training and eight hours of field experience. Participants must be at least 14-years-old.

Rock climbing will be on Sept. 6, 13, 20 and 27 from 7-10 p.m. at the Farmington Hills City Hall, 31555 Eleven Mile. A day outing will be at Grand Ledge. Cost is \$39.

Participants will learn and use basic

concepts of safe rock climbing. Instruction will include set up on belay systems, rappelling, use of equipment such as ropes and harnesses. Minimum age is 14.

Wilderness Survival will be on Sept. 7, 14, 21 and 28, from 7-10 p.m. with a weekend outing on Oct. 1 and 2. Classes will be in Farmington Hills City Hall. Cost is \$39. Minimum age is 14.

Participants will learn how to cope with weather conditions, equipment

failure, and other emergency situations through basic information on fire building, shelter construction and the proper use of natural resources.

The duck identification clinic will be on Sept. 7, 14, and 21 from 7:30-10 p.m. in Farmington Hills City Hall courtroom. Fee is \$2.

The Michigan Duck Hunter's Association will be conducting a three session clinic which includes duck identification, bone structure, point value of ducks and habitat.

Administrator named captain in reserves

James G. Broderick, of 22275 Green Hill, Farmington Hills, was promoted to the rank of Army Reserve Captain, recently.

Broderick a nursing home administrator in Novi, serves as officer in charge of the medical section of 300th Military Police Prisoner of War Command, Livonia.

He was originally commissioned as a lieutenant through the ROTC program at the University of South Dakota, where he graduated in 1971.

The 300th comprises 28 units and more than 1,400 Army Reservists, located in 13 cities in Michigan, Indiana, Illinois, Missouri and Iowa. The wartime mission of 300th units would include the operation of prisoner of war camps as well as other military police functions.
