**Thompson-Anderson**

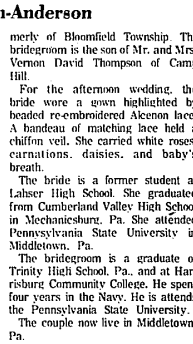
Nancy Stewart Anderson and Stephen Jesse Thompson were married July 9 at the Camp Hill Presbyterian Church in Camp Hill, Pa.
