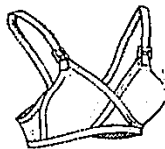

Lions fry fish Friday

Quick! When someone says, "Fall Festival Friday," what's the first thing that comes to mind?

The Plymouth Lions Club Fish Fry, of course.

The annual fish fry, which has become one of the biggest happenings of festival weekend in recent years, will begin at 11 a.m. and continue throughout the day until some 3,400 dinners have been sold.

Last year, the Lions ran out of dinners in the evening hours as more than 3,200 dinners were served.

This year's menu includes not only the fish and french fried potatoes, but also cole slaw, roll and butter, and beverage. The price for all this food is only \$3.

All 55 members of the Plymouth Lions Club are involved in bringing the annual dinner to the community. And with the special help

from all the members' wives, you will see over 100 people working to get you that hot, delicious meal.

Frank Tanner is this year's organizer of the dinner and will head all the volunteer work by members.

All the money raised throughout the Lions' Dinner will go back into the community-as is true for every festival organization.

The main objective of the Lions is to help the community with sight and hearing conservation. The service offered to fulfill this goal finds the Lions helping to pay the medical expenses for people who can't afford proper eye and ear care.

One major project presently under consideration is building bridges in the Plymouth Township Recreation Park on Ann Arbor Trail and McClumphia Roads.

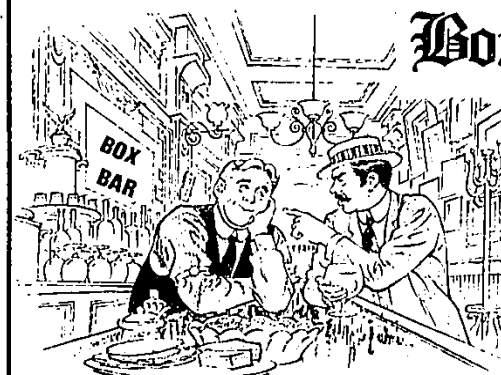
