### Funding uncertain

# CART fate remains undecided

By MICHAEL MATUSZEWSKI It may be some time before the Oak-land County Advanced Reservation-ransit System (CART) will be shuttling residents around the county. The state highway lobby has bottled up state funds which were to have been used to vmplement the county-wide. "Dial-a-Ride" transit program, said Shan Topiwalla, Oakland County's federal and state aid coordinator. The funds will be tied up until the Michigan Supreme Court decides whether the money can, under the state constitution, be used for mass whether the money can, under the state constitution, be used for mass transit. The money, collected through the "a-cent gasoline tax, had been used to construct and maintain the state's highways.

AS A RESULT, the Southeast Michigan Transit Authority (SEMTA) has been unable to purchase the necessary equipment.

Initially, a fleet of 36 passenger vans was to have provided service 12 lour a day, six days a week. This phase was to have been implemented this fall.

row. Topiwalla said, it would take anywhere from three to six months to put the county-wide Dial-a-Ride system into operation. He said county officials and SEATA were completing arrangements to bring easy transportation to county residents. He said county officials and SEMTA were working together with local communities to complete arrangements or OCART even though it will have to wait to put the busses on the road.
