## Burdakin named to jobs commission

Gov. William Milliken recently appointed Birmingham's John Burdakin, president of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad Co., to the newly created Michigan Job Development Authority. Milliken said, "The objective of the authority is to alleviate and prevent unemployment by providing additional means of financing industrial construction."

According to the state's executive of-

fice, the authority may assist in financing the construction, acquisition, expansion or rehabilitation of industrial buildings, machinery and equipment. The authority will be empowered to issue and sell bond notes to finance its projects.

Burdakin, who has served as president of Grand Trunk Western since 1974, said he is not sure how the authority will go about creating jobs,

and midwestern states, has witnessed the industrial flight to the booming southern Sun Belt states.

"In order to have a strong economy, we have to have a strong economic and business base. We must have a strong, energetic business climate," he said.

He said free enterprise was the "only way to go."

The key to having that energetic business climate is having jobs. "That's the goal and that's the key."

The Job Development Authority has not met as a group. Their first meeting is scheduled for Sept. 29.

Milliken appointed five others to the authority including James F. Anderson IV, president of the Summit Steel Processing Corp.; Robert P. Briggs, former commissioner of the Financial Institutions Bureau; Odessa Komer, vice-president of the UAW; Erwin L. Koning, retired senior vice-president of the National Bank of Detroit; and Lowell W. Perry, personal director of Chrysler Corp.'s Automotive Manufacturing Group.



## Holiday driving is safer

Michigan's long Labor Day holiday proved to be one of the safest on record.

According to state police statisticians, 14 people lost their lives in 11 fatal accidents—nearly 50 per cent fewer than a year ago. Labor Day in 1976 claimed 31 traffic accident victims. The 17 fewer deaths this year have been credited to various factors.

Col. Gerald Hough, state police director, said that extra trooper patrols had a definite impact. "Our participation in the four-state highway patrol effort was one contributing factor," Hough said.

Michigan, Ohio, Indiana and Illinois committed extra patrol assignments. Michigan had 800 additional patrol

shifts over the holiday period.

Hough also cited a growing public awareness of safer driving habits and the current campaign promoting seat belts as a positive factor.

"Although we don't have any direct information that more people are buckling up," Hough said, "the promotion of seat belt use may be making some impact."

In the 11 fatal accidents over the 78-hour holiday period, seven (63 per cent) involved drinking to some degree. Multiple crashes killed five people. A double accident in Grand Traverse County involving two motorcycles claimed two lives and three were killed in a two-car head-on crash on I-75 in Crawford County.
