The Jacoby Transfer bid is used in responding to a one notrump opening bid. It was introduced to the American bridge players by Oswald Jacoby in 1956. Two diamonds shows hearts and requires opener to bid two hearts (two hearts would require opener to bid spades).

This convention increases the chances that the strong hand will be the declarer in a suit contract.
