

Farmington Hills Parks and Rec enters fall fun

Elementary school students will have a chance to participate in eight weeks of classes and activities in the Farmington Hills Parks and Recreation after school program.

Pre registration is suggested. Registrations will be accepted at first class meeting if there is room. Classes won't be conducted on Nov. 8, election day.

FUNASTICS which combines gymnastics and tumbling will begin in October and will feature classes for students from kindergarten to teenagers. There is a \$6 fee.

Shiawassee's classes will begin Oct. 24. Participants ranging in age from kindergarten to teenager will be grouped according to age for hour-long classes that will be conducted between 3:30 p.m.-4 p.m.

Fairview gym will be the site of funastics classes geared for the kindergarten to sixth grade groups between 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m. beginning Oct. 10.

Flanders gym will host the same age groups, beginning Oct. 11 from 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m.

Gill school gym will host classes for kindergarten through teens beginning Oct. 11.

CREATIVE ART classes for kindergarten through second grade will give lessons in painting, drawing and imaginative crafts. There is a \$6 fee.
