Nichols servoid as police commissioner in Detroit during the early 1870s but wais fired by then Mayor Roman Gribs when he refused to resign his post after declaring himself a candidate for mayor. He wound up losing that race to Mayor Coleman Young.

Nichols was later hired as Oakland County Undersheriff by another former Detroit comissioner, county Sheriff Johannes Spreen. Having served in that postition for three years, Nichols says he is coming to the Hills department with an open mind and without preconceived notions.

"I'm like an old soldier and believe

not going to superimpose." he said.
Having served with much larger law
enforcement units. Nichols said he
sees few problems in adjusting to a
