CITY OF FARMINGTON COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS (Summary)

A Regular Meeting of the Farmington City Council was held Monday, December 5, 1977, in the Council Chambers, 2500 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan. Notice of the meeting was posted in compliance with P.A. 267-1976. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 P.M. by Mayor Tupper.

PRESIDENT: Councilman Bennett, Buckler, Tupper, Yoder

ABSENT: Councilman Hartsock

CITY OFFICIALS PRESENT: City Manager Deadman, Attorney Kelly, Director Byrnes, Officer Maddison, Acting Clerk Bushey

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Minutes of other boards were received and filed.

On the basis of the Public Hearing of November 21, and after due deliberation, Council does not find it necessary to improve the Cass Court Cul de Sac at this time. Dr. Lewis W. Hamp, 2220 Farmington Road, withdrew his request for sign variance, as his sign will be mounted directly on the building.

Council voted to continue support of the Girls State Program, and appointed Councilman Buckler to receive the report of the 1978 Girls State Citizen.

The following resolutions were adopted:

- Authorizing expenditure of \$1,680.00 for City's share of clerical staff funding, Oakland County Task Force investigating child slayings.
- Accepting bid of International Salt Company for approximately 1,000 tons of road salt at \$12.50 per ton.
- Authorizing final payment of \$14,003.48 to Abbott-Peterson Contracting, Inc., for work completed, Public Services Facility.
- Authorizing budget adjustments in the 1977-78 Water & Sewer Funds.
- Adopting an agreement with the City Manager.
- Authorizing City Manager to enter into agreement with Oakland County for Community Development.

The following Ordinances were introduced:

- Ordinance No. C-422-77 requiring installation of battery operated smoke detectors.
- Ordinance No. C-424-77 amending Chapter 91, Section F 410.1, City's Fire Prevention Ordinance re: Automatic Sprinkler Systems.

Council received the following reports:

- Public Services Department Quarterly Report (July 1-September 30, 1977)
- Financial Report, General Fund - 4 months ending October 31, 1977

Council approved the following appointments:

- Mr. Tracy Carrey, 3701 Grand River, 3-year term, Board of Review
- Mr. Donald Carrier, 35157 Drake Heights, and Mrs. Helen Durham, 33725 Oakland, 4-year terms, Board of Canvassers.

Monthly bills were approved.

Meeting adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
