Rookie debate team takes championship

A novice debate team from South-field High School has taken a state championship and given coach Arthur Voisin his first state victory in 17

years.

The novice team beat 18 other teams to claim the Novice Debate Champion-ship during recent competition at Marshall High School.

Winning debaters are seniors Mike
Howkins and Robert Beattie, who
argued on the negative side of the
debate, and juniors Shari Wenokur and
Robert Kaner, who took the affirmative side.

Novice debaters are first-year debaters only and may come from all

oceaters only and may come from all class levels. The debate topic this year was "Resolved. That the federal govern-ment should establish comprehensive medical care for all citizens in the United States." The novice team claimed the victory with a 7-i record after besting teams from Southfield-

Lathrup, East Lansing, Mona Shores, Jackson Parkside, University of Detroit and Catholic Central. They then defeated Warren Woods in the stage debate final before an audience of about 500 persons.

Although Voisin has coached at Southfield High for 17 years and posted more than 200 tournament and league tictories, this is the first time a team has taken a state championship.

"I felt like a football coach who had finally won his first game." Voisin told Rick Coldman, assistant editor of the Southfield Jay, the school newspaper." In the past, we have won hundreds of tropbies, but nothing has ever been as great as this.

The Southfield High novices finished in 10th place last year at the state

tournament and in third place the year before.
