Gillespie heads show

Trumpeter Dizzy Gillespie kicks off Allied Artists Composer Concepts 1978 jazz concert series at Orchestra Hall/The Paradise Theatre on Sunday backed by the 16-piece Paradise Theatre Orchestra.

Tickets for both the 4 and 8 p.m. shows and for the entire Composer Concepts series are available at the Orchestra Hall box office and J.L. Hudson's ticket outlets.

Joining Gillespie will be Detroit's Sam Sanders & Visions backed by the Oakland University Jazz Ensemble.

Gillespie, one of the founders of the post World War II modern jazz movement known as bebop first appeared on stage at the Paradise Theatre as a member of the Earl Hines and Billy Eckstine Orchestras of the mid-40s, both of which he served as musical director before forming his historic 1947 big band.

Tom Glazer to perform
