Here are just a few recipes available

from the household items you mention. Window Cleaner—1/2-cup white vinegar to each quart of warm water. Use newspapers to polish for a streak and lint-free finish.

Window Screens—After removing dust, add three tablespoons baking soda to each quart of warm water and scrub with stiff-bristled brush. Rinse and air dry.

Metal Polish—For copper, chrome, silver and brass, use dry baking soda on a damp soft cloth, rinse and buff dry.

carpet Deodorizer—nix one cup vinegar with two quarts warm water. Use pump spray bottle. Spray a small section at a time, and hlot with turkish towelling. Especially good if used immediately on pat stains.
