# Area netters seek Slims berth

Five local girls will have a chance to make a tennis dream come true.

The girls, all outstanding high school players, were selected to participate in a tournament with 11 others from southeastern Michigan. The tournament winner will qualify for the one amateur berth in the Virginia Slims tournament, being held in Detroit's Cobo Hall Feb. 21-26.

The local qualifying tournament, conducted by the Southeastern Michigan Tennis Association, will be held at the Dearborn Indoor Racquet Club, Feb. 3-5. The tournament had been scheduled for last weekend, but was postponed.

Nancy Sellers, a Birmingham woman who serves as publicity chairman for the Virginia Slims of Detroit, said invitations were sent to the top girl tennis players in southeastern Michigan.

Of those who responded, the top 16 players were selected to participate.

The five local girls competing in the qualifying tournament are Julie Bookmyer of Birmingham; Mary Ann Ring of Franklin; and Robbie Ridsen, Nicole Lorenzetti and Meg Meurer, all of Bloomfield Hills.

Ridsen won the state Class A flight one singles championship for Bloomfield Hills Lahser High School last fall. Bookmyer was the Class B top flight singles champion for the Academy of Sacred Heart.

Meurer, who played for Kingswood School in Bloomfield Hills, was second to Bookmyer in the Class B finals. The only match she lost all season was in the state finals to Bookmyer. Meurer had beaten Bookmyer earlier in the season.

Ring was the top singles player from Birmingham Groves High. Lorenzetti didn't play on a high school team last fall. However, she participates in many tournaments throughout the year.

Bookmyer, Meurer, Ring and Ridsen were selected to the Observer & Eccentric's All-Area Girls' Tennis Team last fall for performances at their respective high schools.

The Metro Detroit Post Dealers will provide the trophies for the local tournament. The dealers

sponsor the Virginia Slims of Detroit tourney for the benefit of the Community Trust Fund of the Junior League of Birmingham.

Proceeds from the tournament are used for Junior League service projects throughout the metropolitan area.
