"It is very doubtful that any other subdivision in the city could quality under the community development program."

About \$15,000 will be used for the housing rehabilitation program, in which isoms and grants are offered to conservation the city.

About \$5,000 will be allocated to commune redevelopment of the central business district, including land-caping and upgrading parking lot lighting.

About \$3,000 of the grant is requested for contingency, in case any project cost is underestimated, Deadman added.
