School one says that only the best stitchers should be allowed to touch the work. School two says that everybody in the congregation should be free to par-ticipate. This produces both good and bad needlepoint, at an unpredictable rate, and usually ends up with some pieces being lost, left incomplete, or lying forgotten in the Arizona condominium.

We're trying a third way. Every par-ishioner who wants to, can stitch. And everyone has both the opportunity and the obligation to attend one or two classes every month. Wait a bit and I'll let you know how the Great Exper-iment is working out.

Russian flu is near but not yet here

While area hospitals have so far admitted no patients with Russian flu, there is an indication that this new virus strain may be hovering in the

wings.
A 20-year-old man near Adrian is the first person 'in Michigan to contract the disease, according to University of Michigan researchers.

Co. in Rochester has already started production of a vaccine to protect individuals from this illness. Judging from the experience of the Soviet Union, the new flu virus is expected to affect mainly individuals under the age of 24. UM physician Dr. Arnold Monto said that adults from 24-50 will be relatively protected, especially if they received swine influenza vaccine last year.

The illness caused by the Russian flu virus is similar to that produced by the older type A viruses, he noted, so isolation is necessary to distinguish between them.

Dr. Montb directs the community bralth study of U-M School of Public Health which recently detected the man's case of Russian flu. Such activity is part of the community surveillance of influenza being conducted

the National Institute of Allergy and infectious Diseases. "The isolation of this virus is the first reported Russian flu outside the Rocky Mountain area," Dr. Monto said. "It was found in the midst of an outbreak in Tecumseh (near Adrian) caused by the Texas strains, and prob-ably represents early 'seeding' of the new virus."
