

Eliot Feld to dance with ballet company

Eliot Feld, Brooklyn-born "whiz kid" of the ballet world, will bring his four-year-old "Eliot Feld Ballet" company to Detroit's Music Hall Center for the first time on Friday and Saturday, Feb. 24 and 25.

Feld, former American Ballet Theatre star turned choreographer-director, will dance with his company during the local engagement and prima ballerina Christine Sarry will be at every performance.

It was the compulsion to create and perform his own ballets that led to Feld's celebrated departure from the American Ballet Theatre at the height of his stardom, taking Ms. Sarry and several other talents with him.

Although termed a classic ballet choreographer, Feld's creations are spiced with tie-dyed costumes, jazz

rhythms and impossible gymnastics. His choice of music ranges from Strauss to Copeland to Gershwin, and his themes likewise range from Wild West to Judaism to Fred Astaire. This fascinating variety has its roots in Feld's broad dance background. At age 11 he was the prince in George Balanchine's "The Nutcracker." He became a modern dancer with Pearl Lang, a Broadway gypsy in Jerome Robbins' "West Side Story" and "Fiddler on the Roof," and a hoodler on the Ed Sullivan and Garry Moore television shows.

Evening performances for the "Eliot Feld Ballet" are at 8:30 p.m. on Friday and Saturday, Feb. 24 and 25. There will also be a 2 p.m. matinee on Saturday.

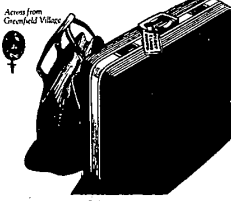
