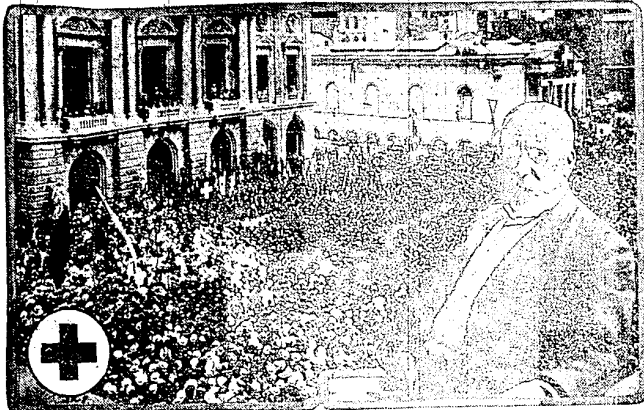
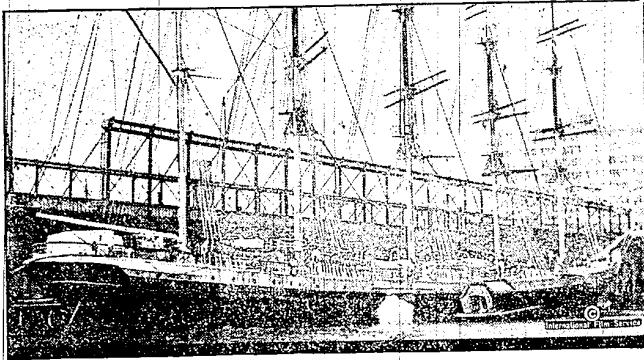


## GREAT RED CROSS DEMONSTRATION IN GENEVA



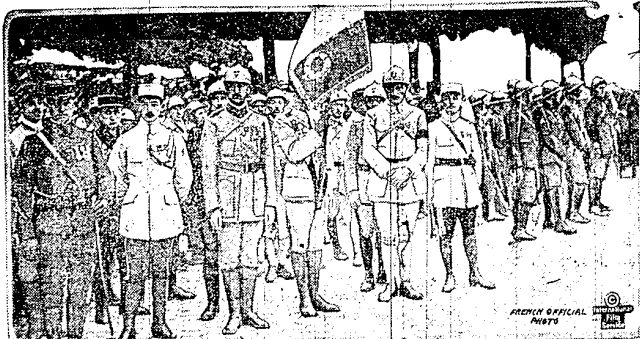

## WORLD'S BIGGEST SAILING VESSEL IN AMERICA



The largest and fastest sailing vessel of the world, the five-masted bark France of Bordeaux, painted a pure glistening white, put into an American port recently after running the submarine gantlet. The captain said he had had a couple of brushes with German submarines, but that his 60-millimeter guns mounted on the stern had made the submarines keep their distance. Under a fair breeze the France can make 17 knots an hour, and in a calm her two Diesel engines can give her a speed of ten knots. She is 400 feet in length, 75 feet beam and has a tonnage of 7,000.
