



Live stock is marketed from farmer to consumer at a lower cost than almost any other farm product.

The United States Department of The United States Department of agriculture reported in 1916 that the farmer gets for his cattle "approximately two-thirds to three-fourths" of the final retail price paid by the consumer for the resulting beef.
