Literary Wealth in Bibles.

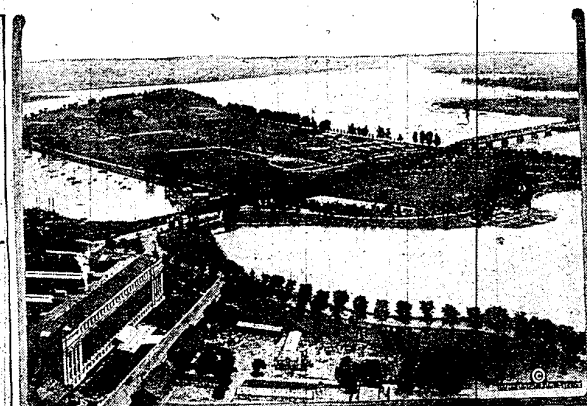

WRECK OF CIRCUS TRAIN AT GARY, IND., WHICH COST MANY LIVES



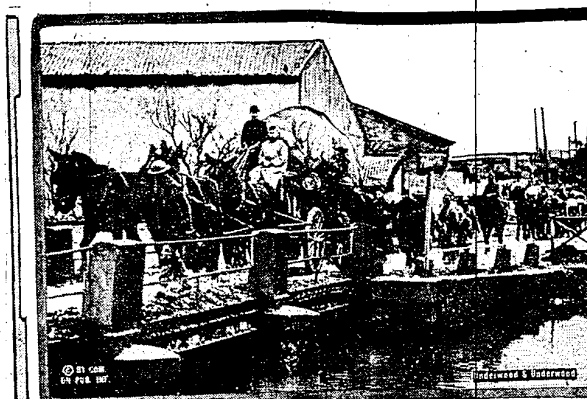

BIRD'S-EYE VIEW OF WASHINGTON IN WAR TIME



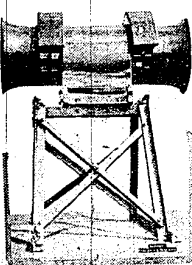
