

WE, THEREORE, the Representatives of the UNITED STATES of AMERICA, in General Congress, Assembled, appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the vectatude of our intentions, do, or the Name, and by Authority of the good People of these Colonies, solemoty publish and declare. That these United Colonies, note are, and of Right might to be IREE AND INDEPENDENT STATES, that they are Abouted from all Alleganites to the British Crown, and that all-political connection between them and the State of Gene Rivinian, is and ought to be foldly disolvel-knad that as Free and Independent States, they have full Power to Irey War, conclude Pears, contract Allianers, establish Commerce, and to do all other Asts and Things which INDEPENDENT, States may of-right do AND for the support of this Declaration, with a firm relation on the protection of Divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other and Lives, our Fortuners, and our sacred Honor.
