

Air show scheduled

Detroit's third annual air show, featuring aerobatics by plane, helicopter, glider and parachute, will be held at 2 p.m. July 17-18 at City Airport, 11800 Conner near Gratiot.

Advance sale tickets are available at Hudson's, Sears, Grumet's and the airport.

Area resident handles show

Jay Finney, son of Mr. and Mrs. Jared Finney, 31448 Sunset Drive, Birmingham, is producing, directing and performing in the Sunset Cabaret Theater at the Douglas House Hotel in Houghton. The season July 4 through Aug. 28 will include "The Fantasticks," "A Theater Carnival" and "You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown." The air show, which attracted some 30,000 people last summer, will include daily performances by:

- The Red Devils Precision Aerobatic Team—three aerobatic pilots flying midjet biplanes
- The Silver Eagles—U.S. Army helicopter stunt team
- The Golden Knights—a team of world champion U.S. Army skydivers and parachutists
- Prof. Art Scholl's "Ballet in Blue" Aerobatics

A new act this year will be a series of glider stunts by sail plane pilot Oscar Bosch. A flying circus, including wing-walking, car-to-plane transfer by ladder and other aerobatic maneuvers will perform both days.

Returning again this year to the air show will be aerobatic pilots Bob Lyjak, Joe C. Hughes and Jim Myrning. Airport gates will open at 10 a.m. and free parking will be available. Air show proceeds will be used to defray expenses of the show and for City Airport improvements.

'Applesseed' show opens
