## OU hosts sports clinic Aug. 15-20

Oakland University will host the August 15-20 Instructional Football Camp. The camp, for boys ages 8-18, will stress fundamentals by position with teaching techniques in passing, receiving, punting, ball handling, running, blocking, pass defense, kicking stance and starts. The camp also stresses motivation, confidence, sportsmanship, leadership and instructional skills. Campers are housed in the college dorms and use the recreational facilities and swimming pool.

Special quarterback teaching sessions will be conducted by Coach Al Fraccas of Brother Rice. The camp is headed by Walt Baylwick, Catholic League Director. Baylwick was a very highly successful high school coach elected to the Michigan High School Coaches Hall of Fame in 1972. He is a national consultant on Youth Football and has been involved in clinics and pro scouting.

## Top tennis pros compete in state's richest tourney

Tennis professionals from Russia, India, New Zealand, Australia and England, along with a father-son team and top netters from ten states, are among the entrants in Michigan's richest open doubles event, the Cunningham's Tennis Tournament.

Sponsored by Cunningham Drug Stores, Inc., the Cunningham \$7,500 will be held July 15 at the new Farm Club in Dearborn. All proceeds from the events on July 1 and 3 will be donated to the Police Athletic League of Detroit (P.A.L.).

Local players highlight the entries. Jon Handline and Dale Ogden—Handline, of Troy, is the top ranked player in southeastern Michigan. Ogden, from Bedford, Texas, is a University of Houston All-American and Southwestern Conference doubles champion.

Ham Richardson and Kevin Richardson—the elder Richardson is a former No. 1 ranked singles player and will team up with his 16-year-old son Kevin.

Fritz and Hans Guldemeier—a pair of brothers from Ohio. Hans will also team with brother Fritz's wife Diane for the mixed doubles action. Hans and Diane Guldemeier are one of the top mixed doubles teams in Ohio.

Valery Mandansky and Al Aaron—Mandansky, a native of Russia, is a former Leaning City Tennis Champion. Aaron is a teaching pro at Centaur Farms Racquet Club in West Bloomfield.

The five-day tournament will include men's doubles action, women's doubles, mixed doubles and a junior mixed doubles invitational. The amateur junior players will represent tennis clubs from the metropolitan Detroit area.

On July 4, there will be a \$2,000 winner-take-all mixed doubles exhibition between Ham Richardson and Valerie Ziegenfuss, and Rudy Hernandez and Trish Faulkner. Ziegenfuss is a member of the Virginia Slams Women's Tennis Tour. Hernandez and Faulkner are the 1976 Michigan State mixed doubles champions.

Faulkner is a former touring pro and is currently the tennis pro at the Square Lake Racquet Club in Bloomfield Hills. Faulkner and Hernandez are considered the best mixed doubles team in the Midwest.

Richardson and Ziegenfuss will also participate in a celebrity match with local media stars.

Richardson, formerly ranked first in the U.S., will team with Channel 2 newsmen Joe Glover against Ziegenfuss and Channel 2 sportscaster and former Detroit Tiger Jim Price. The match will be July 4 at 1 p.m.

In qualifying matches, which began June 28 at the Western Racquet Club in Livonia, Lee Koenig and Paul Seibert, both of Birmingham, lost to Joe Fodell and Joe Shaheen in the second round by 6-1, 6-3 scores. Koenig is the pro at the Birmingham Country Club.

Also in qualifying action, Tiger Keating and Mike Farah, from Birmingham, advanced in the tournament by defeating Brian Lambert and Rick Shabene 6-4, 4-6, 7-5. They will play at the Fairlane Club in Dearborn July 2 against Greg Norton of Ohio and Scott Mulgrew of Indiana.

Tighe, a 21-year-old, was undefeated during the 1975-76 season as a member of the Michigan State varsity tennis team. He is currently the pro at the Western Golf and Country Club and is ranked in the top ten in southeastern Michigan in singles competition.
