

Father of country dreamed of the future



Every American is familiar with the story of George Washington and his troops suffering through the agonizing winter of 1777-78 at Valley Forge without food, clothing or warmth.

Starving (or fasting) men often experience hallucinations, visions and unusual psychic experiences. The father of our country was no exception. He described his experience to his close friend, Anthony Sherma of Philadelphia.

Sherma was so impressed that he took care to write down every detail right away. He told the story again and again during his long lifetime. It was published in a Mormon periodical in 1880 and in the National Tribune in December 1889.

AFTER SPENDING several hours alone

in his quarters, Washington came out and told Sherma and another officer that he had looked up to see a beautiful woman standing beside him.

Whether she was a ghost or an angel, he could not say—but his visionary visitor addressed him as "Son of the Republic" and inspired him to "look and learn" as a whole vapor rose and came from the future.

The slave problem, the Civil War and the Union's triumph all were foretold in detail. It is true that these things had already taken place at the time of the National Tribune report in 1889.

Washington's vision did not stop there. The apparition also declared to him great events, the likes of which he had

never seen, springing up from the Atlantic to the Pacific; three earth-shattering world wars, the third to be the most fearful; and internal turmoil much like that our government has experienced recently.

Washington's words were, "I don't know whether it is owing to my own anxiety of mind or what."

Whatever caused him to have the vision, it has proven quite accurate to date.




