A September wedding is planned.



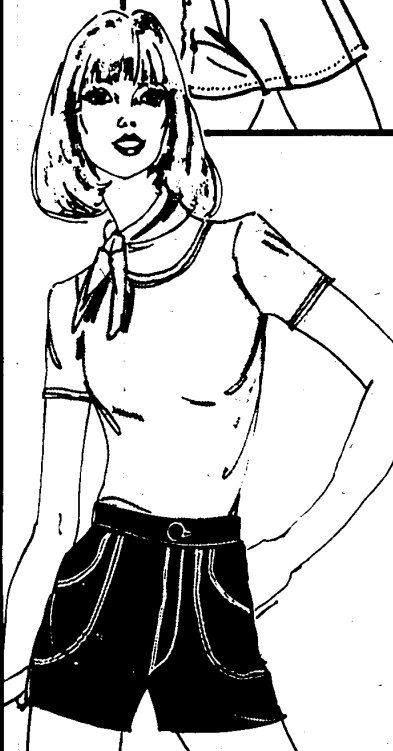
Mrs. John Wunderlich
