Time to pick up the car and start east down Grand River. The home of Dr. Ann H. Samborski, 32600 Grand River features Greek Revival accents with an early Victorian-style Mansard roof. The oldest part of the home was built in the 1810s. The living room floor is secured with wooden pegs.

The Farmington Historical Commission is now in the process of installing markers on many of the homes mentioned plus other sites of special significance.

The same types of projects are being carried out in Farmington Hills, although documentation is not as far along.

The drive through Barmington Hills is less rigid. There are two homes on Power which runs north from Grand River, between Orchad Lake and Farmington. It logs to the right at Shia-WIRHING.

The Robert Rowe home, 24770 Power, is between Een and Eleven Mile. Built in the 1850s, it. has some Greek Revival characteristics.
