A "throw in" or end play is where an opponent gains the lead but it costs a trick, sometimes more, to do so. The tenace throw in — the opponent is forced to lead from a broken holding — costing a trick.

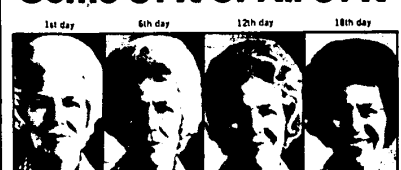
