



Sacred and profane combine

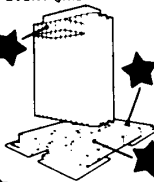

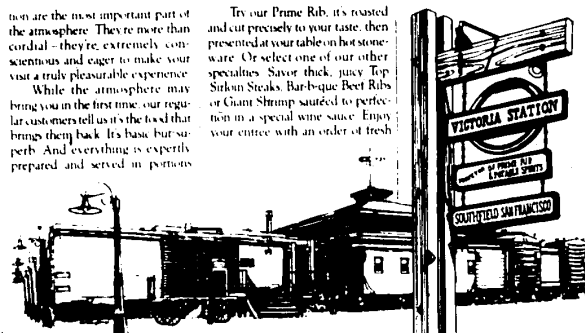
