

56 repeats 'attack'

"Attack Heart Attack," the award-winning, four-part special produced by Channel 56, WTVS-TV, in cooperation with the Michigan Heart Association, begins its encore run this September at 9 p.m. Wednesdays.

When the show premiered in the spring of 1975 on the Southfield public television station, each show brought an average of 1,300 calls from viewers who directed their questions to a panel of medical experts during the live segment.

During the encore presentation, viewers again will be invited to phone in questions. The series begins Sept. 19 and among the panel of experts will be Southfield cardiologist Dr. Oswald Bostic.

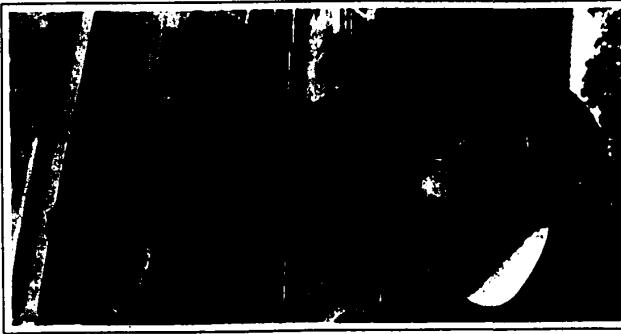
