The couple plan to be wed in August, 1977.



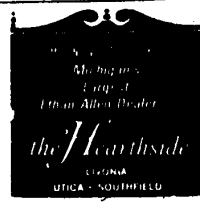
**Mr. and Mrs. Club installs officers**

**Continuum Center begins workshops**

The Continuum Center for Adult Counseling and Leadership Training at Oakland University will launch its fall program with a one-day workshop Sept. 11 on Alternative Career Options for teachers.

The teachers' workshop begins as an exploratory program in 1974 and attracted so many participants that it is now being offered for the 12th time.

Beginning Personal Growth (BPG) for Women, which draws participants aged 21 to 64, will begin with a free orientation 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Sept. 15 in the Oakland University Clubhouse.

Other BPG programs scheduled for fall include BPG for Women, a daytime program at the Northwest Unitarian Church in Southfield, Oct. 5 to Oct. 26, and BPG for men and women, a nighttime program at the Church of Our Saviour in West Bloomfield, Oct. 25 to Dec. 6.

A two-day session in Introductory Transactional Analysis (TA) will be held Sept. 18 and 19, followed by TA and Weight Control, Oct. 28 and 31, and a TA Scriptshop, Dec. 11 and 12.

Three communications workshops are planned, one for individuals, Sept. 21, for couples, Oct. 1 and for men only on Oct. 11. Men and women are also invited to Careers in Transition, Sept. 23 to Oct. 30; Assertiveness Training, Sept. 23 to Oct. 14 and Dec. 19, and to Values Clarification workshops, Oct. 2 and Dec. 4.

Other programs offered at Continuum Center that fall include a workshop for divorced men and women, Oct. 21 to Nov. 18; Getting It Together, Nov. 5; Marriage Enrichment, Nov. 13-14; Career Development for Women, Nov. 8 to Dec. 1 and leadership training for community groups, still to be scheduled.

In addition, programs for older adults include Personal Growth for Older People, 1-3 p.m. Sept. 28 to Nov. 18 at Barmann Jr. High, Birmingham, and Oct. 6 to Nov. 17 at Oak Park Senior Citizens Activities Center, and Assertiveness Training for Older People 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Sept. 27 to Oct. 18 at Barmann Jr. High, Birmingham.
