Smith was president and chief executive of Lynn Smith Associates, Inc.

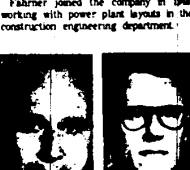

Brady, who worked two years in the Birmingham City Engineer's office, joined Barton-Malow in 1964.

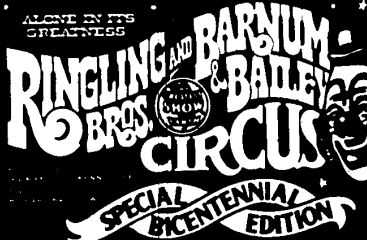

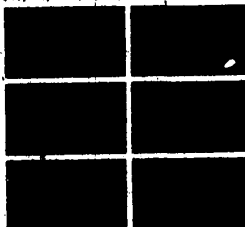
