The New Jerusalem Players, a group of young evangelists from "Jews for Jesus," will give a program in Northwest Christian and Missionary Alliance Church at 7:30 p.m., Sept. 22.

The church is located at 28111 Ten Mile, Farmington.

The four-member group is one of the Mobile Evangelistic Teams sent out by Jews for Jesus to bring a Jewish message about Jesus to cities and towns across the country.

J'han Moskowitz, the youngest member of the group, at 27, says, "The message that there are Jews for Jesus and that Jesus is for the Jews has largely been ignored throughout history. So we needed a dramatic way to catch the attention of the public. We're letting people know that salvation in Christ is for everyone, everywhere."

The dramatists he speaks of is through a Jewish-Christian street theater presentation, wearing colorful costumes and face make-up to draw attention to issues people are facing today.

Two other members of the team are Mr. and Mrs. Alan Bond. They met while they were both studying at Oklahoma Baptist University, and were wed in a Jewish-Christian ceremony in 1974.

Mrs. Shirley Kraft of Southfield, a life member of the Women of the Jewish National Fund, twice past president, former chairman of the board and currently program chairman, will be honored at a JNF Israel Bond Luncheon.

Mrs. Kraft will receive the "Kish" Award from the State of Israel at the Tribute Luncheon on Tuesday, Oct. 19 at Congregation Adat Shalom in Farmington Hills.

Guest speaker will be Mrs. Munt Wahl, an Israeli economist.

Mrs. Kraft's late husband was a communal leader and, in his memory, she has established the Jules and Shirley Kraft Family Forest in Israel, the chapel at Hillel Day School, a room in the synagogue building of Congregation Adat Shalom, where she is a member, and a room in the Jewish Home for the Aged.

The honoree is a past board member of Adat Shalom Sisterhood, a volunteer and board member of the Women's Guild of Sinai Hospital, a member of ORT, Jewish Home for the Aged, B'nai Brith Women, United Hebrew Schools, and Harlan (Canadian born, she came to Detroit in 1930 and in 1932 married).
