

JNF Bond Luncheon cites Southfielder

Mrs. Shirley Kraft of Southfield, a life member of the Women of The Jewish National Fund, twice-past president, former chairman of the board and currently program chairman, will be honored at a JNF Israel Bond Luncheon.

Mrs. Kraft will receive the "Koah" Award from the State of Israel at the Tribute Luncheon on Tuesday, Oct. 19 at Congregation Adat Shalom in Farmington Hills.

Guest speaker will be Mrs. Mark Wahl, an Israeli economist.

"Koah" is Hebrew for two words: "28", the age of the State of Israel, and "energy," the theme of the year's Israel Bond Campaign.

Mrs. Kraft's late husband was a communal leader and, in his memory, she has established the Jules and Shirley Kraft Family Forest in Israel, the chapel at Hail Day School, a room in the synagogue building of Congregation Adat Shalom, where she is a member, and a room in the Jewish Home for the Aged.

The honoree is a past board member of Adat Shalom Sisterhood, a volunteer and board member of the Women's Guild of Sinai Hospital, a member of ORT, Jewish Home for the Aged, B'nai Brith Women, United Hebrew Schools, and Barilan.

Canadian born, she came to Detroit in 1930 and in 1933 married. She is the mother of Gerald, an economist living in Boston, and the grandmother of two.

An Israel Bond leader since the program's inception, she has helped in this

area by opening her home for many leadership receptions.
