The owners of Farmington's Roman Terrace are switching from ice skates to ice skates when they open the Runkade Lounge on the grounds of Centaur Farms, West Bloomfield, Oct. 17.

Robert Fracchia of Farmington, and his partner, Robert McDonald of Farmington, have joined six area business men in transforming the stables into an indoor skating rink and driving range with restaurant.

Paul Jolson of Farmington, Abe Seleny of Southfield, Jack Roberts of Farmington, Roy Runhart of Westland, John Pelec of Westland, and Robert Brinkworth of Union Lake are partners in the enterprise.

"Each has a specialty that he brings into the partnership," Fracchia said. "Bob and I are running the restaurant because that's our specialty."

PART OF THE 34,000-square-foot indoor stable which stands on seven acres has been renovated into a restaurant with a disco.

"I don't think my partners would like it if I said how much we paid for the building. We got a good deal. That's what gave us the idea for the complex," Fracchia said.

"The renovation cost us \$500,000," he added.

"The building used to be the Centaur Riding Arena. It has three barns coming out of an arena, like fingers. The restaurant will be overlooking the ice rink."

Runhart decorated the eatery in browns and silvers with butcher block tables.

"My partner says it's decorated in art deco," Fracchia said. "I think you could call it contemporary. We have track lighting."

Diners will have their choice of sandwiches, hamburgers, corned beef, frozen yogurt and pizza.

"If someone's on a diet kick, we'll have something for them to eat," Fracchia said. "But we're not a health food restaurant. We cater to everyone."

Wine on tap and mixed drinks will be available.

Dinners will cost about \$5 and alcoholic beverages will average \$1.50 a glass, according to Fracchia.

The upper deck disco, reached by a spiral staircase will be open six nights a week. The restaurant will be open all week.

Fifty patrons will share the upper portion and 150 can eat downstairs.

"I HOPE WE GET 200," said Fracchia. "We let them stand."
